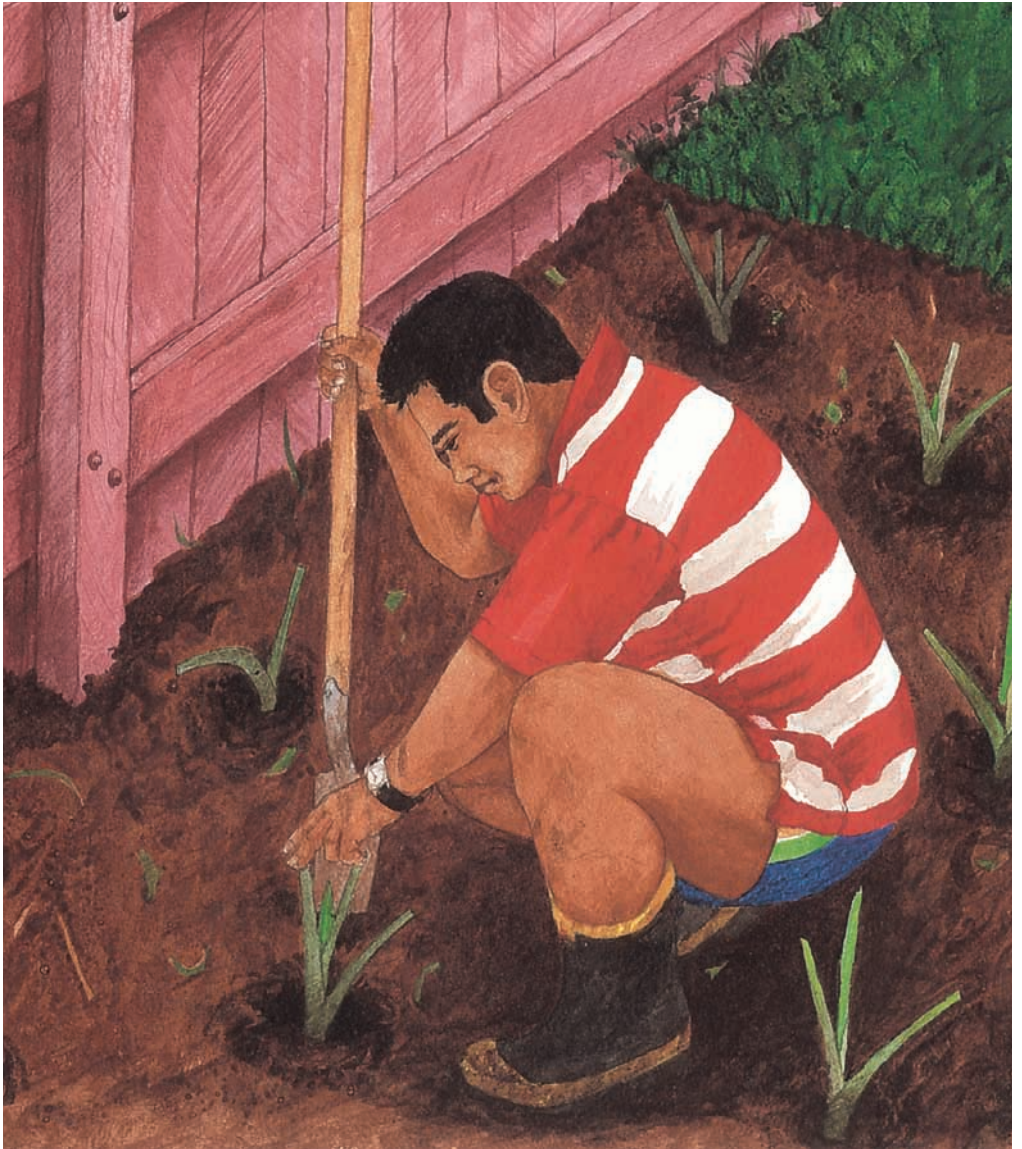
Tono likes to help his dad
plant talo.



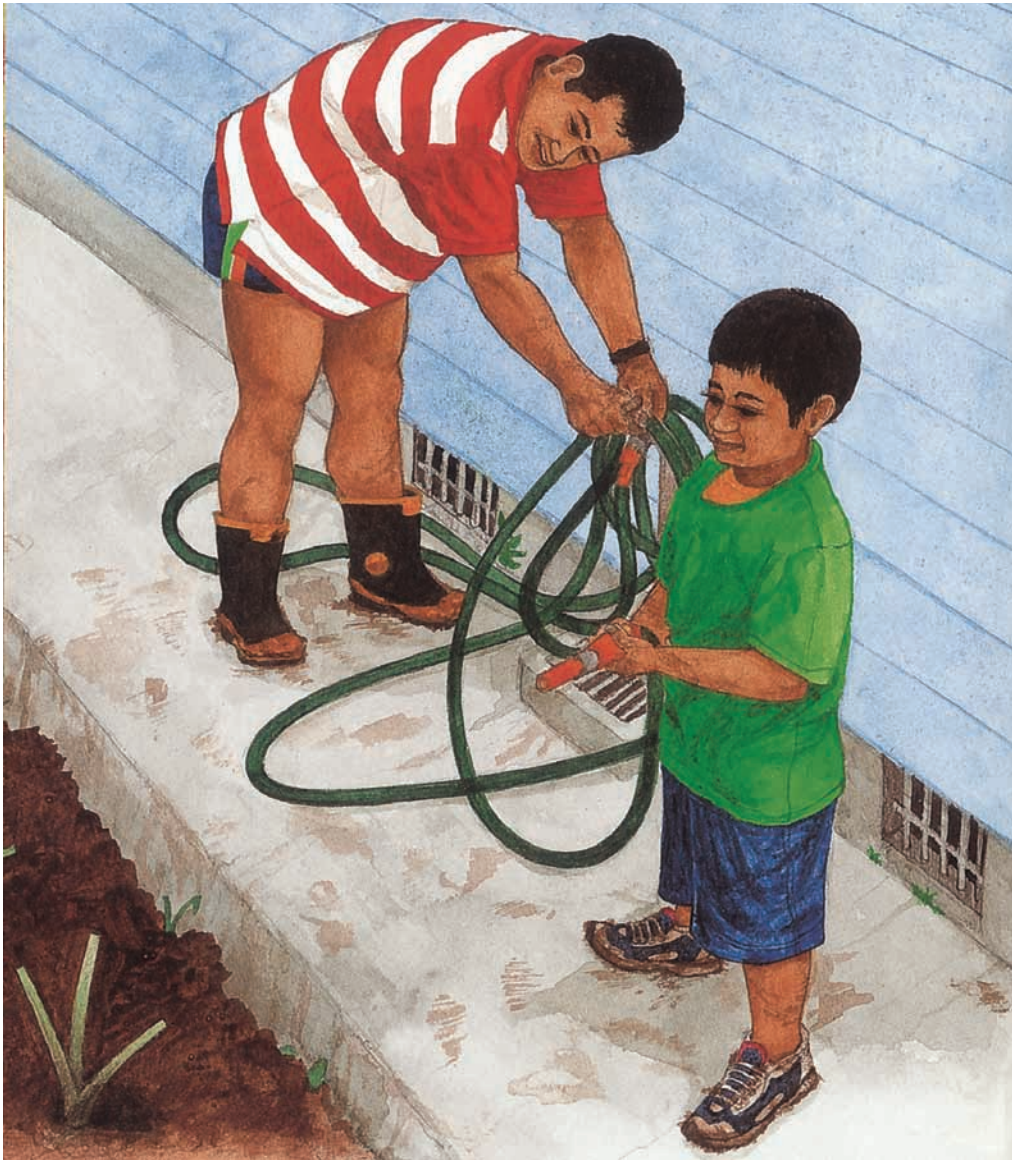
They dig the holes together.

Dad covers them with soil.

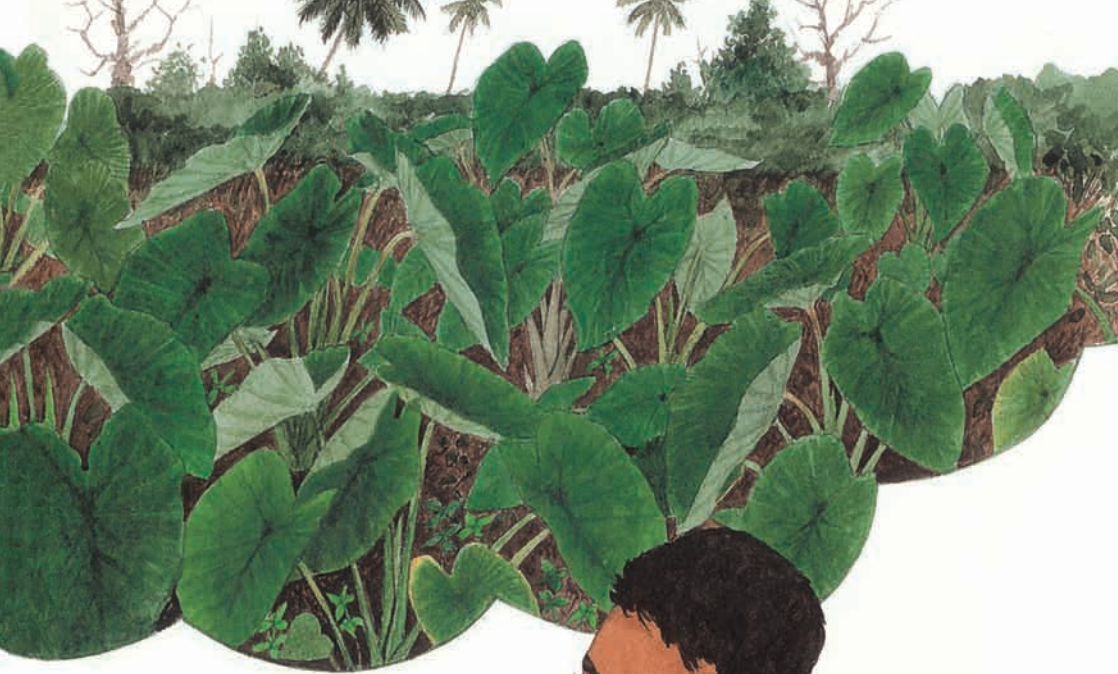


Tono holds the hose.
